


He is especially proud of his writing in the past year, and his book, "In the Margins: A Transgender Man's Journey with Scripture," is about to be released by Eerdmans, a major Christian book publisher. To celebrate this momentous event, St. Peder's is sponsoring a book launch party, in collaboration with Moon Palace Books, here at the church on **Wednesday, August 17**th. **Program starts at 7pm**. Please come to congratulate Shannon and to have one last chance to visit with him in person!

This special evening will consist of storytelling and reading from the book, as well as time for Q&A. We'll also hear music from Kith + Kin Chorus, an uncommon choir in the Twin Cities, which strives to build community, spread joy and give in service to others through harmony (and which has been using St. Peder's for its rehearsals). After the program, there will be a reception and book signing.

In the Margins weaves stories from Shannon's life into reflections on well-known biblical narratives—such as Jacob wrestling with the divine, Rahab and the Israelite spies, Ezekiel and the dry bones, and the transfiguration of Jesus. In each chapter, he shows how stories have helped him make sense of his own identity, and how those same stories can unlock the transformative power of faith for those willing to listen with an open mind and stand alongside him in the in-between. The book demonstrates the unique and vital theological insights transgender Christians can provide the church.

In the Margins is available for pre-order now, wherever books are sold, for \$19.99, but Moon Palace has offered **St. Peder's members a bulk rate of \$17 per copy for those who sign up in the office no later than Wednesday, August 3.** (Advance sales before the official release date of August 9 will help Shannon a lot!). We will be using this book for a book study in the fall, and Shannon has agreed to join us by Zoom for the first session. Sign up today to get your discounted copy, come August 17 to get your book signed, and finish it before the book study begins!
