

Funerals at St. Peder's Lutheran Church

Funerals and memorial services at St. Peder's are Christian celebrations of the promises of resurrection, eternal life and reunion with those we love. These promises are ours because of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

The worship service: the music, liturgy, prayers and sermon will have this theme. If a family member wishes to say a few words of thanks during the service, this too, is appropriate but not required. A eulogy by a family member or friend appointed by the family is also appropriate if desired. The eulogy during the worship service is to be prepared and not spontaneous. A more spontaneous sharing of memories and remembrances is appropriate and encouraged for the time of fellowship and reception which may follow the service. (Inclusion of a eulogy should be discussed with the pastor when planning the service.)
